To determine if changes on primary net enrolment is statistically significant, paired student's t-Test was done. As a result, on average, the difference between 2019 and 2020 primary net enrolment rate is statistically significantly greater than zero at 5% confidence level. This means that 2019 primary net enrolment rate is on average higher compared to 2020.

To determine a linear relationship of economic and COVID-19 related variables, a series of pear R correlation tests were conducted. The values in Table 2 below are the correlation coefficient that ranges from -1.0 to 1.0. Values closer to -1.0 denote strong negative correlation while closer to 1.0 denote strong positive correlation. Cells highlighted in yellow are correlations that are statistically significant at the 5% level. The bullet points below summarize the result of the series of correlation tests:

- Countries who were performing better in 2019 in terms of GDP growth rate are positively correlated with GDP growth rate of 2020.
- The variable country international tourist receipts is negatively correlated with GDP growth rate of 2020. This means that the higher the international receipts in 2019, the lower the GDP growth rate in 2020.
- Country cumulative cases of COVID-19 is negatively correlated with GDP growth rate of 2020.
- Country social protection coverage (both with at least 1 social protection and coverage on vulnerable populations) is positively correlated with persons fully vaccinated per 100.
